Manner of lodging applications under section 18 (research and demonstration licence – application) of the Regulations

1. By sending the application to the Offshore Infrastructure Registrar by email to: offshoreelectricity@nopta.gov.au; or
2. By accessing an account in the NEATS Secure Portal (**the Portal**) on the website of <https://secure.neats.nopta.gov.au>, and submitting the application in the Portal, or
3. By prepaying and posting the application, in hard copy or on a USB, addressed to the Offshore Infrastructure Registrar to:
